I have introduced 16 bills so far this Legislative Session, including legislation that would continue to make it easier for our Basic Life Support (BLS) Ambulances to respond to emergencies, providing additional legal protection for our law enforcement and first responders while they perform their duties, ensuring life insurance plans for members of the Pennsylvania Army and Air National Guard cover all types of activations, and reducing the regulatory burden when applying for a permit to clean and maintain our creeks and streams. I believe these bills align very well with the conservative values shared by the great people of Lycoming and Sullivan Counties.

I look forward to championing our rural voice in Harrisburg.

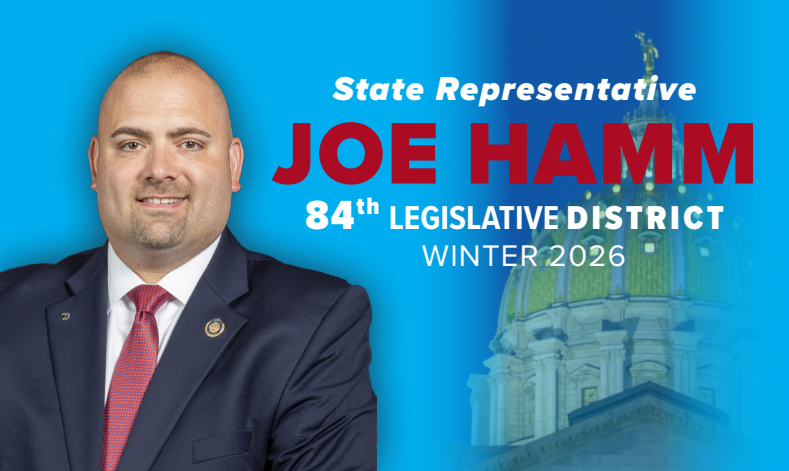
★ FIGHTING FOR ELECTION INTEGRITY

DO YOU HAVE UNCLAIMED PROPERTY?

The Pennsylvania Treasury Department administers the state's Unclaimed Property Program, which may include abandoned or forgotten bank accounts, stocks, uncashed checks, unused gift cards, life insurance policies, proceeds from safe deposit boxes and much more.

It's easy—and free—to track and claim unclaimed property by visiting www.patreasury.gov and searching the database, or by calling Treasury at **1-800-222-2046**. Again, there is no fee associated with this service. If you would like our assistance accessing this information, please feel free to contact one of my District Offices.

SUPPORTING PA VETERANS

To serve constituents in the 84th District, William McGovern, a Veterans Service Officer from the American Legion, holds monthly service hours at my Montoursville district office every
